Observations:

- Students' response exhibits progression and development in all aspects as reflected through the questionnaires.
- Students' response shows that students are mostly satisfied with the resources provided so far, by the University.
- However, following suggestions have been provided by the students in Suggestions section:
 - a) Wi-Fi internet facility should be made available in the Academic Building.
 - b) A Canteen should be established.
 - c) Security in the periphery of the Academic Building should be enhanced with high powered lights and security personnel.
 - d) More academic departments should be opened.
 - e) Adequate number of faculty members in each academic department should be appointed.
 - f) More books and journals should be procured in the library.
 - g) Library should be automated and digitalized.
 - h) A cycle, bike, car stand; Boys' and Girls' Hostel; Student Amenity Centre; Well-equipped gym, Sports facility and Health centre should be constructed.



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Action Taken Report on the Observations of the Student Feed Back Analysis

On the basis of the Students' Feed Back Analysis, the MBB University Authority has taken the following initiatives for the betterment of the students of the University.

- The University library procures new books in regular intervals for the academic Departments to cater the academic needs of the students.
- Net connectivity has been extended to the Academic Block. Wi-Fi connectivity will be extended.
- A Cycle Bike and Car Stand has been constructed in the Academic Block.
- A facility to establish Canteen for the students has been developed in the Academic Block and the canteen will be functional shortly.
- Reverse Osmosis Water Purifiers have been installed in the Academic Block to make purified water available to the students.
- A lift has been installed in the Academic as well as Administrative Block to help the movement of the Differently abled students.
- High powered electric lights have been installed and extra security personnel have been deployed around the academic block to ensure the security of the students after sunset. Local police station has been requested to patrol the campus in regular intervals to ensure better vigilance.
- The University appoints Guest Teachers in different academic departments according to the requisitions of the respective departments, to fulfill the shortage of permanent faculty members.
- The University has published an advertisement in the leading dailies for filling up newly created permanent faculty positions in different academic departments of the University.
- The opinions and requirements of the students as well as alumni are taken into consideration while framing and modifying the academic curriculum of the departments.
- Various academic programs such as, MA in History, PGDLAN, MLISc, IMD in Chemistry, IMD in Commerce and Diploma GST have been introduced by the University to widen the scope of higher education in various disciplines.
- The University has introduced MA in Kokborok and the Department will be functional after the recruitment of the permanent faculty members. In this regard University has already published the advertisement in leading dailies inviting applications from the eligible candidates.

- The University has a mission to construct an auditorium and necessary action has already been taken.
- The University has a plan to construct Students' Hostel and Students' Amenity Centers shortly. The work to construct an Open Air Theatre has already been started.
- The teachers are requested to enhance the Student-teacher interactions through group discussions on various topics of the curriculum beyond the class room.
- Teachers have been instructed to use more ICT enabled tools and study materials, such as slides, ebooks etc. for easy communications with the students.
- Teachers have been advised to regularly provide study materials in abstract format to the students.
- More efforts to be given to increase the student participation in various extracurricular activities such as Cultural Programs, Quiz, Debate, Extempore, Sports, Drama, Adventure etc. as well as community engagement to foster social responsibility.
