





### From the Desk of the Vice-Chancellor

Maharaja Bir Bikram University started its maiden journey on 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2015. The establishment of this University was to make the dream of Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya Bahadur turn into a reality. He dreamt for a scheme, known as 'Vidyapattan', for a place of higher education. And this is the very reason that the University is named after Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya Bahadur. It is a State University which is established through the Maharaja Bir Bikram



University Act, 2015 (Act No. 6 of 2015), and thereby, passed by the Tripura Legislative Assembly. Since, its establishment, so far, five academic sessions have been completed. But the session, i.e. 2020-2021 was a very significant year since the world had faced Covid-19, its impact, and a lock down during this session. Covid-19 had a profound effect on the education sector which made the teacher-student relations offline to online. And as a result, due to the implementation of lock down, the academic activities in the education sector tremendously affected the psyche of students and teaching faculties.

But unlike the other Universities, MBB University started its academic activities in the first week of lock down itself. The faculty members of the University started online teaching from their home. Despite Covid-19 posing as a threat and a challenge in itself, MBB University has organised an international webinar on "Covid 19: Issues and Challenges on Economy, Politics and Society" on 29th May 2020, probably the first in the North-East India. The webinar was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tripura Sri Biplab Kumar Deb. It was attended by the Vice-Chancellors and academicians of different institutions. Other webinars included were: An International Web Conference on Advance Research in Science, Humanities and Social Science (IWCARSHSS 2020) was held on July 9-10, 2020; "Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyay and His Relevance in Contemporary World" on 24th September 2020; "Pandemic Pedagogy: Issues and Challenges" was held on 24th July, 2020 etc. among others and many such were organised. The University has also conducted all its Post Graduate Examinations in a regular manner. The faculty members have also participated in various workshops and webinars all throughout the year. The faculties have also published articles in various journals of repute. During the Pandemic period, the registration fee collected through seminars have been contributed to the PM CARE fund and CM Relief fund. During this period, faculty members and staff of the University contributed to the Government relief fund and also as part of outreach programme distributed food items among the needy people of the surrounding villages.

### ANNUAL REPORT 2020-2021

Once the affects of Covid-19 were seemingly reduced, the University had also started classes and conducted examinations and organised seminars in physical mode. The University has also published its Peer Reviewed Journal 'Adhyayan'. During this period for skill development, one professional course, Diploma in Goods and Services Tax and two Integrated Master Degree Programmes in Commerce and Chemistry have also been introduced which ultimately increased the intake capacity of the University.

It was during this period that the University has also received the recognition from University Grants Commission under 12B.

This Annual Report of 2020-21 is the reflection of round the year activities of MBB University. Despite of constraints, our academic commitment towards the state of Tripura and to meet the challenges of changing global education scenario remains immeasurable.

### **Concept Note:**

The government of India has been adopting various measures for socio-economic development of the tribes after India's independence. Most of the developmental programmes are directed towards supporting the underprivileged sections of the society. To achieve this objective, various anti-exploitative and protective measures have been taken. The problems of tribal development, in fact, have puzzled the policy makers, administrators and scholars because the problems of hunger, starvation, poor shelter and exploitation faced by almost all the tribal groups of this country are crying for solution.

Over the years, it has been noticed that the government's intense efforts to draw the tribes into the wider economic frameworks of the country through legislative protection and progressive socioeconomic programmes have not met with much success. Numerous tribal development programs have helped the tribes, but marginally. Almost every kind of professionals like anthropologist, social worker, bureaucrat and politician and so on, have offered numerous suggestions to improve tribal life, but with meagre outcome.

This brings into question the role of the approaches and policies on development administration of the tribes undertaken by the government of India. 

### **Concept Note**

Buddhism and Sanatana Dharma have a great root and exerted enormous influence on the civilizations of South East Asia. Both religions were fused together to shape states and societies in the early South East Asia. Today, although Buddhism remains as the religion of the majority in Myanmar, Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Thailand and Vietnam, yet the underlying influence of Hinduism remains visible in Indonesia, Cambodia and Malaysia.

The earliest material evidence of Hinduism in south East Asia comes from Borneo, where late 4<sup>th</sup> century Sanskrit inscriptions testify to the performance of Vedic sacrifices by Brahmans at the behest of local chiefs. The dominant from of Hinduism exported to South East Asia was Shaivism along with Vaishnavism. Later, from the 9<sup>th</sup> century onward, both Hinduism and Buddhism spread throughout the region. Beginning in the first half of the 1<sup>st</sup> millennium CE, many of the early kingdoms in south East Asia adopted and adapted specific Hindu texts, theologies, rituals, architectural styles and forms of social organization that suited their historical and social conditions.

Ramayan, Sanskrit, Ayurveda, Hindu values, meditation, Hindu festivals, puranas, dance, music, sculpture and arts remain the bedrock of the culture and existence of South East Asia for the past two thousand years. The ruins of Wat Angkor and Prambabab temple in Central Java stand testimony to the great Hindu influence in the last fifteen centuries. In fact, most of these countries were ruled by Hindu empires. Hinduism in South East Asia influenced the Champa Kingdom in Vietnam from 192 A.D. through 1697 A.D., influenced the Srivijayan Kingdom in Sumatra from 200 A.D. to 1400 A.D, the Singhasari Kingdom and Majapahit Empire in Java, Bali and a number of islands of the Philippines archipelago. The civilization of Bharat influenced the languages, scripts, calendars, artistic and culinary aspects of these people. Ramayana and Hindu culture have been the source of inspiration throughout the history of South East Asian countries. Many cities of South East Asia still bear the names of Ayodhya, Lavapuri, Kanchanaburi, Chandrapuri, Vishnulok. Examples, Singapore, the city of lions, Jayakarta, the city of victory, Bandar Sri Bhagwan (the capital of Brunei. Laos is named after Lav, the son of Ram and Burma after Lord Brahma, the God of Creation. Buddhism is thought to have entered South East Asia from trade with India, China and Sri Lanka during the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> centuries. One of the earliest accounts of Buddhism in South East Asia was of a Theravada Buddhist mission sent by the Indian emperor Ashoka to modern day Burma in 250 BCE. The development of trade amongst merchants of the region long the Silk Roards resulted in a further expansion of Buddhism towards eastern Asian lands, especially in

Thailand and Indonesia regions, where excavations displayed the interactions of these lands with Buddhist institutions linked to trading groups.

The attraction of Buddhism and Hinduism in South East Asia was as much political as spiritual. They had political role in giving legitimacy to rulers and in consolidating their position. The arrival of Buddhism and Hinduism also brought an elaborate system of beliefs and rituals. But, such beliefs did not displace at all the pre existing indigenous beliefs and worships.

### **Concept Note:**

Buddhism and Sanatana Dharma have a common past. They are the two oldest and ancient religions in India. We can think of Buddhism in terms of three main categories - philosophy, science and religion. The religious part involves principles and practices that are of concern to not only Buddhism alone, but the Buddhist philosophy of interdependence as well as the Buddha science of mind and human emotions are of great benefit to everyone.

#### **CONCEPT NOTE**

The term environment is derived from the French word: 'environia' means the sum total of conditions that surround us at a given point of time and space. According to the UN Convention on environment, environment is the sum of all social, biological, physical and chemical factors, which compose our surroundings. Ecological balance is necessary for environmental health. But our anthropogenic sociological understanding on the relationship between man and environment led to the gradual degradation of ecological balance. When environmental security was not an issue of top priority till beginning of 1970s, environmental problem is now recognized as one of the major global problems. The quality of our environment depends not only on what we do at home, but also on activities outside our border. Therefore, a part from domestic actions, it necessitated comprehensive international efforts to protect, preserve and enhance the environment. Environmental protection has become an issue of global concern because effects of environmental degradation on humans, animals, plants and eco systems have been far reaching. Climate change, gradual depletion of fossil fuels, ozone depletion, rise of sea level and ocean pollution, loss of bio-diversity, floods and draughts and are other forms of environmental havocs are some of the important environmental issues and challenges which draw our immediate attention. Pollution growth with gradual depletion of natural resources also exacerbated social tensions and even provoked armed conflicts in many parts of the world. Sustainable development, reduction in the use of and less dependence on fossil fuels and use of clean and green energy, environment friendly technologies, environmental awareness and multilevel governance for environmental administration up to local level are now recognized as some effective actions and means to address major environmental threats. 

### **Concept Note**

It is believed that, the Northeast participation in India's freedom struggle is a tale of valour and courage which started in the 19th century itself with a mass peasant uprising against the British and resistance by the hill people. The political events in the rest of the country culminating in Independence in 1947, found a strong support and response in this region. Initially the rebellions were spontaneous in nature with it mostly involving disbanded rulers, disgruntled landlords and tribals who were evicted from their lands. But later in the 20th century, the struggles followed the patterns of the national movements being an inherent part of them. For example the Ahom revolt, Khasi revolt etc. followed the same strategy.

The Northeast region of India went into the hands of the British starting with the occupation of Assam in 1826, after a decade of Burmese control of the land. Till then, the region remained mostly independent under the control of the Delhi Sultanate or any other external power. Assam especially faced many incursions, but thwarted them. Thus, the independent spirit of the Assamese people showed in the immediate challenge to the British rule by a group of the erstwhile nobility led by Gomdhar Konwar. Their attempt, however, was suppressed in 1828 and Gomdhar and his associates were imprisoned. One of his associates Piyali Borphukan was hanged.

British expansion to the hills faced fierce resistance from the hill tribes. The Khasis led by U Tirat Sing fought valiantly against the British from 1829 to 1833. Between the 1830s and 1860s, the hill tribes such as the Singphos, Khamtis, Nagas, Garos, etc. also offered stiff challenge to the British expansionist policies toward the hills, causing heavy losses to the latter. There was Phulaguri peasant uprising in 1861 in the Nagaon district of central Assam against the repressive agricultural policies of the British government. It heralded a new era of peasant protest in the state. The Assam Association pursued constitutional methods for redressing the grievances of the native population but it also announced full support to the Non-Cooperation Movement of Gandhiji in 1920. There had been many legendary freedom fighters such as Kanaklata Barua, Paona Brajabashi, Bir Tikendrajit Singh, Rani Gaidinliu Haipou Jadonang, U Tirot Sing Syiemlieh, U Tirot Sing Syiemlieh, Moje Riba, Gopinath Bordoloi, Tarun Ram Phookan, Nabin Chandra Bardoloi, Chandranath Sarma, Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed, Debeswar Sarma, Siddhinath Sarma, Omeo Kumar Das, Bijoy Chandra Bhagawati and many others who had fought against the British colonial administration in various forms.

INA's operation in Manipur itself reflects a new dimension of the freedom movement in Northeast India. The contribution of Northeast in the Second World War is an unexplored zone for forgotten heroes of the region.

However, despite the significant contributions of the North-East India in the freedom struggle, unfortunately history continues to discard and ignore these brave nationalists while writing the freedom movement of India.

The was one of the removated 1800 contact intellectuals of India, the was called as "Sind River of Kindness because of his sympathy and pain for the more and downtrodden people. He had extensive contribution in diverse fields more particularly in the fields of social reforms, editor-fine and development of Bengali literature.

The contemporaries of Vidyasagar Dayananda Saraswati, Keshab Chandra Sen, Raja Rammohon Roy played great role in different areas. But Vidyasagar was exceptional to his contemporaries because unlike them Vidyusagar was not only a social reformer and a philosopher, but he was also a great educationist and a philanthropist. He was perhaps the first Indian to put forward the issues of women. He fought against the practice of child marriage and dedicated his life's energies ensuring an end to the practice of child marriage. He strongly advocated for removal of all obstacles to marriage of Hindu widows and contributed greatly to passing of the Hinda Widow's Remarriage Act on 16th July 1856. He also fought a determined bartle against the then prevailing social custom of Kulin Brahmin polygamy.

As an educationalist, he initiated unprecedented changes in education and administration in education. He invoured universalisation of education believing that everyone irrespective of easte or gender had the right to education. 
